**WELLSPRING REPORT**

Following our third Parish Wellspring meeting last week we established three working groups to look at the areas of Liturgy, Adult Education and Poverty Relief in the life of the parish.

In **Poverty Relief** we set as our goals the establishment of the St Vincent De Paul in St Stephen's, the study of the Church's social teaching on getting to the root of the causes of poverty, outreach to those who may not ordinarily access assistance, a form of advocacy to help access to benefits and advice and engagement with the parish to garner the help and advice of parishioners with professional skills and experience in this area. **Liturgy:** examination of the liturgical strengths and areas of growth in the five Sunday Masses in the parish, advise leaflet for the bereaved, Masses for the sick and the sacrament of anointing, the establishment of the Children's Liturgy in All Saints'.

**Adult Education** helping us to growth in faith spiritually and intellectually; opening the RCIA programme to parishioners, looking at Church's Seasons of Advent and Lent for spiritual and catechetical engagement, a Mass for the Sick with anointing and veneration of the relics of St Pio, setting up Padre Pio prayer group, study day on New Lectionary.

Many thanks to all those who attended the meeting and joined the 3 Working Groups. I am grateful for your assistance. **Fr Doyle**

Today the Catholic Church in Great Britain and Ireland marks our annual Day for Life, established by Pope Saint John Paul II to recognise the value of human life at every stage and condition, and to draw attention to the seriousness of abortion and euthanasia and other aspects of human life deserving our consideration. In recent years our Day for Life Collection has helped fund our traditional pro-life organisations as well as supporting survivors of sexual abuse and those with addictions and caring for refugees and asylum seekers. This year's theme, *The Lord is My Shepherd*, focuses on Compassion and Hope at the End of life against current efforts to legalise assisted euthanasia.
