This year's theme is *'The Wonder of the Child in the Womb'* and reflects on the humanity of the unborn child and acknowledges, with compassion, the deep grief experienced by parents who lose a child before or shortly after birth. POPE LEO AND AI: Marking the 135th anniversary of *Rerum Novarum*, Pope Leo XIV releases his first encyclical, entitled *'Magnifica Humanitas: On Safeguarding the Human Person in the Time of Artificial Intelligence.'* He appeals for the safeguarding of humanity, promotion of truth, dignity of work, social justice, and peace. "We all need to learn how to engage with the digital world in a human way, as an integral part of our education in the faith and in a life lived according to the Gospel. Indeed, we must consider the digital world as a new continent to be evangelized, one that requires generous missionaries who are mature in the faith" (paragraph 238).
