As David selected five smooth stones and used his sling to defeat the giant Goliath, so too does the Rosary serve as our spiritual sling. With each decade representing a stone, the faithful use the Rosary to conquer their spiritual adversaries. This story is recounted in 1 Samuel 17:40, where David's trust in God and his simple but effective tools mirror our use of the Rosary beads to meditate and call upon divine aid in our battles.
