Wednesday 25th The Annunciation of the Lord
Sunday 29th Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord.

ON THE FEAST OF THE ANNUNCIATION, we celebrate the moment the Angel Gabriel sent by God announced to Mary that she was called to be the mother of Jesus. Mary's "yes"—*fiat*—shows her perfect trust, turning her fear into surrender to God's will, altering the course of history. Like Mary, we are called to trust God's plan, even when it is confusing or brings uncertainty. The Annunciation reminds us to be open to God working in our lives, turning our own "Let it be" into daily acts of faith. Mary's "Yes" was a complete surrender to God.
