effective manner Christ's loving and sovereign reign over each of us, our families, society, governments, and nations. The eternal values of truth, love, care and charity remain the foundation of every society and family, these are the values of God's kingdom and are proclaimed to the world as the Good News of the Gospel.

The Feast of Christ the King is celebrated on the last Sunday of the Church's Year and places before us the certain hope that Christ shall come to judge the living and the dead. It is the final image placed before us to remind us that human life has a final and profound purpose. Next Sunday the Church begins the season of Advent.
