Mystery of the Most Blessed Trinity: The Catechism tells us "It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the 'hierarchy of the truths of faith.'" The mystery of the Trinity, therefore, enlightens the mystery of Creation, the mystery of Redemption, the Mystery of Sanctification. It illumines every page of Sacred Scripture. It sheds light on the four last things. It reveals what is at the root of all of the sacraments and prayer. The Catechism states, "The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men 'and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin.'" Underneath the history of the world, underneath our own personal history from the moment of our conception in our mother's womb, until now and beyond, has developed within this mystery of the Blessed Trinity. Therefore, it's crucial for us as human beings, not to mention believers, to pour ourselves into the mystery of the Trinity. On Trinity Sunday we recognise too our Baptismal identity as Sons and Daughters of God the Father, Brothers and Sisters of Jesus Christ our Lord and Temples of the Holy Spirit.
