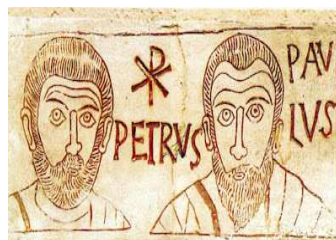

Donating to Peter's Pence is a concrete gesture of communion with the Holy Father and closeness to his mission of proclaiming the Gospel and bringing hope and love to every part

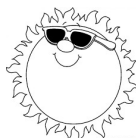

**PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO ROME
24TH TO 27TH SEPTEMBER 2027.**

DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO WHITHORN. A 2-day trip has been organised for 29th/30th August to join the National St Ninian's Pilgrimage to Whithorn. We will be accompanied by Bishop Toal and will be staying overnight at the Premier Inn in Dumfries. The cost of the trip is £159 pp for a twin/double room and £189 pp for a single room. The price includes coach travel from Motherwell, dinner, bed and breakfast, and fish and chips on the return journey. Pilgrimage of Reparation and Prayer for the Sanctity of Life, Saturday, 1st August, Carfin Grotto

The day is expected to conclude at approximately 4.30pm. Pilgrims are asked to bring a packed lunch and water for the day. If you are able to join this special pilgrimage in honour of Our Lady, please go along and pray for the needs of the Church in Scotland.

THE UK-WIDE LISTED PLACES OF WORSHIP GRANT SCHEME has closed, and the replacement fund applies only in England. For many parishes and dioceses in Scotland, this means essential repairs and improvement projects for listed church buildings will become more expensive, placing further pressure on already stretched budgets. You are encouraged to write to your MSPs to ask for clarity on support in Scotland and to back a practical Scottish funding route.

MASS FOR THE PEOPLE OF VENEZUELA will be celebrated in St. Leonard's Church, East Kilbride, on Sunday 5th July at 12 noon. A special invitation is extended to those of the Latin American diaspora who wish to gather in solidarity and prayer for all affected by the recent earthquake.
