THEME:

First Reading: Daniel 7: 13-14

Daniel's vision is one in which God conquers over all that is evil, cruel and abusive, and restores the triumph of Goodness.

Second Reading: Apocalypse 1: 5-8

The word "apocalypse" may suggest drama, horror, vengeance and violent upheaval. But John's vision is one in which the enemies of God's purposes will be confounded, not by being overthrown but by realising the immensity of God's love.

Gospel: John 18: 33-37

Jesus comes face to face with the greatest power in the world, with nothing but the weapon of truth as his protection. Salvation is accomplished by one who looks like a failure, but even the great empire of Rome cannot overcome the love and mercy of God
